A Model United Nations (MUN) is an activity which engages students with the work and importance of the United Nations by taking on the roles of ambassadors and other diplomatic figures from a nominated UN member state, or from the UN itself.

They first research and then debate issues of global importance, which could be actual or imaginary scenarios.

MUN simulates a real United Nations conference. It lets delegates explore the art of diplomacy and master skills in research, analysis, critical thinking, writing, teamwork, debate, mediation and leadership. MUNs vividly demonstrate the interdependence of nations, non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and other players in resolving international issues.

At this event, the Model United Nations Society of the University of Warwick will give a presentation and simulation of an MUN. Teachers and their students will gain a flavour of the fun and excitement of an MUN.
