After the war, Coventry became the UK's first and only city of Peace and Reconciliation. And the Peace Festival commemorates the great trials endured by the city during.

In 2020, 80 years after the bombing, United Nations Association Coventry Branch invites you to test your puzzle-solving skills with our newly designed word search puzzles which focus on the concepts of peace and its opposite: conflict.

These puzzles present you with words concerned with peace and conflict, and we hope that, as you search for these words amongst the letters, you will reflect upon how we can reduce conflict in our every-day lives.

The puzzles are organised in 5 stages of increasing difficulty. We have to warn you that Level 5 is very difficult, so be warned!

Interesting Facts

- The United Nations was founded in 1945 to save succeeding generations from the scourge of war.
- But, despite its good intentions, a war has broken out on average every four months every year since then.
- Nevertheless, in the twenty-first century, most regions of the world are more peaceful than they have been for generations – if not ever
- The Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which was created in 1948, has been translated into over 500 languages
- International law prohibits world leaders from starting aggressive wars unless it is for self-defence or it has been authorised by the UN Security Council
- We spend much more money on war than we do on peace. Global spending on arms is approximately \$1.8 trillion and the cost of war is around \$1trillion but the entire UN system costs around \$50billion
- Before the creation of the United Nations, the League of Nations was created following World War 1 but had to be replaced due to its failure to prevent another major war
- Ever since the Global Peace Index was created in 2008, Iceland has been voted as the most peaceful country each year
- The Greek Goddess of Peace was Eirene
- In recorded history since 3600 BC, over 14,500 major wars have killed close to four billion people – two-thirds of the current world population
- In armed conflicts since 1945, 90 percent of casualties have been civilians compared to 50 percent in the Second World War and 10 percent in the First
- The first distribution of the Nobel Peace prize took place on December 10, 1901, the fifth anniversary of Alfred Nobel's death, and was awarded to Frederick Passy and Jean-Henri Dunant
- The main function of the United Nations is to preserve international peace and security
- The International Day of Peace, or Peace Day, is held on 21st September every year



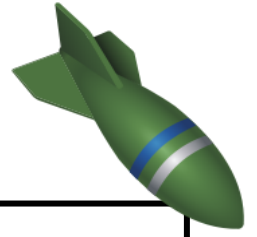
